Construction Dewatering Operations 4-Hour Training Class

This half-day class is designed for construction personnel and others conducting dewatering operations during construction activities. Successful dewatering operations include the methods and practices implemented to remove water accumulations from excavations and managing discharges so they will not have a negative impact on water quality.

Discharges from Construction Dewatering activities may impact water quality and therefore appropriate techniques and Best Management Practices (BMPs) are necessary to minimize these impacts. The course will address topics that will prepare students for the proper selection, application, and implementation of these BMPs. Information provided will include a training manual.

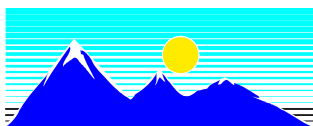
