The SMEC class is offered as a one day online class or a day and half in person program. The in person class has as the second half day a field trip to a construction site. *The classes in Oct. and Nov. 2021 are tentatively scheduled for in person.* It is not known currently what restrictions may be in place so these offerings could change to online. This introductory program focuses on the installation and maintenance of Control Measures (Best Management Practices) for erosion and sedimentation on construction sites. The class also covers the requirements of the construction stormwater permit. This is an excellent class to build your knowledge of permitting requirements and control measures to protect water quality. This course meets the prerequisite requirement for the Qualified Stormwater Manager (QSM) certification program.

- The Stormwater Program permit requirements and Stormwater Management Plans (SWMPs).
- Erosion and Sedimentation at construction sites.
- Types of Control Measures for specific conditions to control erosion and sedimentation.
- Installing and maintaining construction site Control Measures
